VEHICLE VS TRAIN COLLISION

Today, January 13, 2022 shortly before 9:00 a.m. Miami Police responded to the intersection of North Miami Avenue and 20th Street to investigate a traffic crash that involved a vehicle and a train.

According to the on-scene investigation, a white Ford SUV was traveling westbound on 20th Street approaching North Miami Avenue when it stopped on the railroad tracks, ultimately colliding with a train which was traveling southbound at the intersection.

City of Miami Fire Rescue responded on scene and transported two of three passengers to Jackson Memorial Hospital where they remain in stable condition. All identities of those involved are being withheld at this time.
