Subject: **Martin Luther King Parade**



The Parade will take place on Monday, January 18, 2016. It will commence at 11:00 A.M. and ends at approximately 2:00 P.M. within the City of Miami limits. It travels along Northwest 54 Street from 12th Avenue to 19th Avenue, then continues west on 54th Street into Miami-Dade County's jurisdiction.

Street closures are as follows:

- NW 54th Street will be closed from NW 7th Avenue to NW 32 Avenue. The adjacent streets south and north of 54th Street (53rd and 55th Street) will be open.
- The street closure will begin at 8:00 A.M.
- The staging set up area is from NW 7th – NW 12th Avenue on NW 54th Street. The staging area overflow will also use NW 7th – NW 12th Avenue extended from NW 53rd to NW 55th Street. Residents that live in the area will be allowed access.
- The parade route will travel west on 54th Street starting at NW 12th Avenue and ending on NW 32nd Avenue.
- Miami-Dade transit buses that normally travel along NW 54th Street will be re-routed. Please check with Miami-Dade Transit Agency.
- Motorists are encouraged to take alternate routes, if they need to travel in the vicinity. City of Miami Police Officers will be placed along the closure to provide any assistance.
- Streets will re-open for vehicular traffic at approximately 5:00 P.M.
