Subject: **2023 MIAMI MARLINS OPENING WEEK**

The Miami Marlins will begin their 2023 season at home on Thursday, March 30th vs. the New York Mets at 4:10 PM. Miami will host the Mets for four games (March 30th - April 2nd).

Approximately 30,000 people are expected to attend the games per day. There will be minimal changes to the maintenance of traffic and/or detours in the area. However, due to the high volume of traffic within and around LoanDepot Park, please expect traffic delays during peak ingress and egress hours between 2:00 PM – 8:00 PM daily.

There are four (4) on-site parking garages available to guest attending the event for \$40.00. Guest can also utilize off-site park and ride, located at NW 2nd Avenue and W. Flagler Street, and utilize the following parking garages with a fee of \$15.00.

- 220 NW 3 Street: West Lot Garage
- 270 NW 2 Street: Hickman Garage
- 50 NW 2 Avenue: MD Cultural Center Garage

The shuttle drop-off location will be at NW 14th Avenue between W. Flagler Street and NW 2nd Street. Guest will then take a short walk to the ballpark. There will be services available for ADA guest who cannot complete the walk to the ballpark.
