RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY

Miami Police Detectives are investigating a burglary that took place at 1866 N.W. 47 Street on Sunday, March 22, 2020.

According to detectives, while the victim was at the property performing housekeeping duties, he realized the rear window was opened. After successfully securing it, he left the property, and returned later the same day to install cameras.

On March 24, 2020, the victim reviewed video surveillance which depicted an unknown black male exit a vehicle (possibly a red Chevy Cruze) and enter onto the premises of the property. Once the victim was able to conduct an assessment of the property, he noticed miscellaneous items totaling approximately \$930.00 was missing.

Detectives are now seeking the communities assistance after exhausting all leads regarding this investigation.
