MIAMI POLICE SEEK PUBLIC'S HELP IN IDENTIFYING BURGLARY SUSPECT

Miami Police Burglary Detectives are requesting the public's assistance in identifying the subject depicted in the "Need to Identify" flyer in connection with two separate burglaries reported in the Coconut Grove neighborhood.

The first incident occurred on December 29th at approximately 1:15 a.m., around S. Shore Dr. The victim reported that when they woke up, it was discovered that the screen to the window was missing and several household items, including silver and gold figurines stolen.

Later the same day, on Tiger Tail Ave, another victim reported that their vehicle was stolen from the front of the home sometime during the midnight hour.

Detectives have reviewed surveillance footage that depicts the subject pictured in the flyer and believe this individual may be responsible for additional crimes within the Coconut Grove neighborhood.
