Subject: DELIVERED PACKAGE THEFT

Miami Police Burglary Detectives are investigating the theft of a package delivered to 4610 N.W. 5 Street on November 26, 2019.

According to detectives, on November 26th, 2019 at approximately 3:20 p.m. the victim's surveillance system captured a suspect walking into the victim's front yard and then walking away with a package under his left arm. The victim had the package delivered earlier that day.

When the victim got home he called police and provided us the surveillance footage. The package contained shampoo and facial cleansers valued at approximately \$30.00.

Burglary Detectives need your assistance in identifying the suspect as the investigation continues.

Suspect: White, possibly Hispanic, male, 50 to 55 years old, 5'08" tall, and bald. He was last seen wearing a black t-shirt, gray shorts, and white sneakers.

Vehicle: Possibly an older model Blue Jeep Liberty or similar vehicle.
