VEHICLE BURGLARIZED

Miami Police are investigating a vehicle burglary which occurred on Friday, October 16, 2020.

According to detectives, shortly after 3:00 a.m., officers responded to a call of a vehicle burglary at 6002 N.W 6 Avenue. Officers met with the victim/vehicle owner who reported that while she was asleep inside the incident location, she heard a loud noise outside. The victim looked through her window and observed two unknown subjects running away from her vehicle.

Video surveillance depicts two subjects who approach the victim's vehicle. Within seconds, one of the subjects can be seen vandalizing the driver's side window, causing approximately \$250.00 in damages. After successfully making their way inside, both subjects began ransacking the victim's vehicle seconds before they fled from the scene.

According to the victim, stolen was cash from the center console.

Detectives are actively investigating this case and need assistance in identifying the subject(s) responsible.

Detectives are looking for:

Suspect 1: Black male. Last seen wearing a white long-sleeve shirt, long light colored pants with white socks and black flip flops.

Suspect 2: White male. Last seen wearing a white colored tank top, dark colored knee length shorts with black shoes.
