Subject: **U-HAUL TRUCK BURGLARIZED**

Burglary detectives are investigating a theft from a cargo truck that occurred on September 2, 2020, at approximately 4:50 a.m., in the parking lot of 6025 N.W. 6 Court.

According to detectives, the victim stated that he has several rental U-Haul trucks parked inside his parking lot. After the victim arrived at the lot, he noticed that three batteries were missing from one of the trucks and the wires apparently had been cut. The stolen batteries are valued at approximately \$2,000.

Surveillance video from the parking lot shows that at approximately 4:50 a.m. the suspect walked into the parking lot while the business was closed and began to cut the wires that were affixed to the batteries. In the video, the suspect is captured rummaging through the truck and eventually walking away with the batteries which he puts inside an awaiting vehicle driven by a getaway driver.

Suspect: black male, possibly 20-30 yrs old, last seen wearing a dark color hooded long sleeve sweatshirt and dark shorts with black and white sneakers.

Vehicle: unknown make or model, possibly a 4-door vehicle.
