Subject: **POLICE INVOLVED SHOOTING**

On April 24, 2020, at approximately 2:10 A.M., a City of Miami Police officer assigned to the Tactical Robbery Unit was in the area of N.W. 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 50<sup>th</sup> Street when she attempted to stop a white Nissan Sentra.

According to the on-scene investigation, the officer's gunbelt's electronic control device and her unmarked police vehicle was struck by gunfire. The officer was forced to discharge her weapon. Three suspects were taken into custody. The other suspects fled the immediate area. With the assistance of Miami-Dade, Hialeah and Miami Beach Police Departments, a perimeter was established in the area where the suspects were believed to have been in.

The wounded suspect was transported with non life-threatening injuries to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Unit via Miami Fire Rescue.

FDLE along with Miami Police Department's Internal Affairs Section is investigating the police involved shooting.
