Subject: MAN SHOT

Today, July 30, 2020, at approximately 1:50 p.m., Miami Police officers responded to 770 Claughton Island Drive, after receiving a 911 call about a man who had been shot multiple times.

According to detectives, an unknown man walked into the Isola Condominium, located at 770 Claughton Island Drive inside Brickell Key Island and went onto the 15<sup>th</sup> floor. It appears the suspect took the elevator and went to one of the apartments on that floor. Once at the apartment door, he was greeted by the resident. The suspect armed himself with a handgun and shot at the victim multiple times, striking him in the abdomen area. The suspect fled the scene and exited the Brickell Key Island in a newer model Blue SUV.

Miami Fire Rescue immediately transported the victim to Jackson Memorial Hospital's Ryder Trauma Center in extremely critical condition.

The motive behind the shooting remains unclear and under investigation. It is unknown if the victim and the suspect knew each other.

### Detectives need to identify and locate:

**Suspect:** White male, slim build, possibly in his 20s, last seen wearing a white helmet and possibly still armed with a handgun.
