Subject: **HSEEP ACTIVE SHOOTER DRILL**

**UPDATE:** the 1:00 p.m. – 3:30 p.m. portion of the training exercise will include the landing of a Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Aero-Medical Transport helicopter at Maurice A. Ferre Park to simulate victims (role players) being airlifted to a nearby hospital.

The City of Miami Training and Personnel Development Section in conjunction with the Miami Fire Department will be participating in a large scale, Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program (HSEEP), **“Active Shooter Drill”** on Saturday, February 26, 2022 beginning at 7:00 a.m. and ending at approximately 5:00 p.m. at the Miami Riverside Center located at 444 S.W. 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue.

There will be a temporary road closure on the westernmost lane (southbound) of S.W. 2 Avenue between 3 Street the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue Bridge. There will also be a temporary closure along S.W. North River Drive/S.W. 3 Street between S.W. 2 Avenue and S.W. 2 Street.

We request media’s assistance in alerting the public that there will be a large scale “Active Shooter Drill” and traffic diversion training exercise occurring.
