Subject: COLD CASE MURDER ARREST



The Miami Police Department's Cold Case Homicide Unit detectives have arrested Deborah Lynn Andrews, D.O.B. 9/22/60 and charged with her with one count of 2nd degree murder with a deadly weapon for the homicide that occurred at 750 Northwest 13 Avenue, on January 9, 2009.

According to detectives, the victim, Ismael Pico, D.O.B. 5/5/65 was at home and found unresponsive by Miami Police officers. Officers arrived to Pico's home only after receiving a 911 call from his then girlfriend, Deborah Lynn Andrews claiming her boyfriend had apparently committed suicide.

Ismael Pico was pronounced dead on the scene by Miami Fire Rescue personnel of an apparent stab wound. Dr. Garavan of the Miami-Dade Medical Examiner's Office determined that Pico's death be ruled a homicide.

Years later and thru thorough fine combing investigation, detectives had enough to arrest Deborah Lynn Andrews and charge her with the murder.
