The Miami Police Department is proud to announce that it has been awarded the prestigious TRI-ARC Award by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). CALEA is the gold standard in law enforcement accreditation, and meeting CALEA's rigorous standards requires strict adherence to dozens of best practices established by respected industry professionals. The TRI-ARC Award is only given to agencies that have achieved concurrent CALEA accreditation in law enforcement, public safety training, and public safety communications. MPD is the first agency in Florida and one of only 19 in the country and 20 worldwide law enforcement organizations in the world to qualify for this distinction. The men and women of the Miami Police Department worked tirelessly to adopt, implement and document adherence to often complicated standards to accomplish the agency's goal of receiving TRI-ARC accreditation in less than two years.
