POLICE-INVOLVED SHOOTING

The City of Miami Police Department is working in conjunction with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) to investigate a police-involved shooting that occurred in the vicinity of N.W. 2nd Avenue and 62nd Street shortly after 5:00 p.m. today.

As a result, one suspect, who was armed with a firearm was fatally wounded. A second armed individual has been taken into custody.

The Florida Department of Law Enforcement has assumed the role as the primary investigative agency. The collaboration between MPD and FDLE ensures an impartial and thorough investigation into the circumstances surrounding the use of force.

The City of Miami Police Department is committed to transparency and accountability in all matters involving use of force by its officers.

As this is an ongoing investigation, specific details regarding the incident will not be released at this time. It is vital that the integrity of the investigation is preserved. Any premature disclosure of information could potentially hinder the investigative process.

We recognize the importance of maintaining open lines of communication and will provide updates as soon as it is appropriate to do so.
