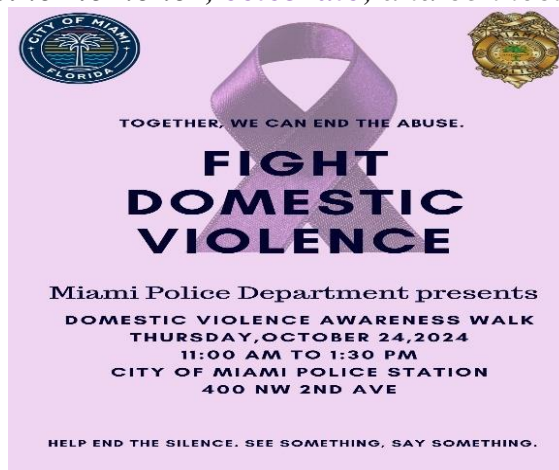
Subject: **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS WALK**
